

## Hansen's investments top Rs 960 cr in Kovai plant

Coimbatore: Hansen Drives, a subsidiary of Hansen Transmissions, a Suzlon group firm, has completed investments exceeding Rs 960 crore for manufacturing wind turbine gearboxes at its special economic zone (SEZ) at Karumathampatty near here.

Hansen had signed a memorandum of understanding with the Tamil Nadu government in June 2008 for establishing the facility with a total investment of Rs 1500 crore, one of the largest outside Chennai. The unit was officially inaugurated by deputy chief minister M K Stalin here on Sunday. The facility, located at Hi-Tech engineering and services sector SEZ and promoted by Synerfra engineering and construction, part of the Suzlon group can make gearboxes for up to 3 mw wind turbines. The company commenced its commercial operations and production in September 2008.
